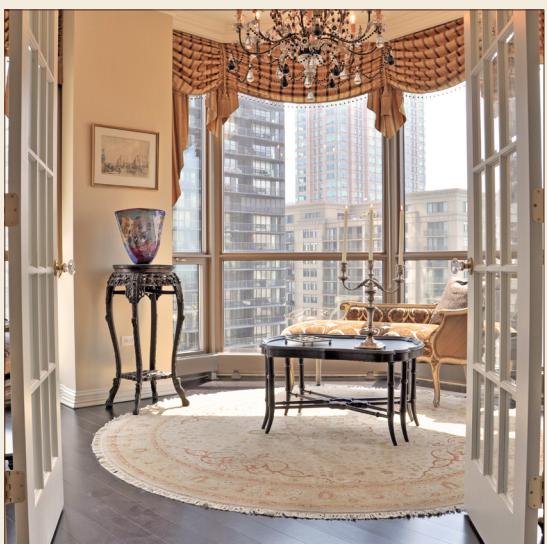

## **Find a color you love.**

## **Determine the feel you want to create.**

Do you prefer bold, colorful spaces or more subdued environments? Perhaps your taste is for something in between. The important part is understanding the feeling you are trying to establish.

## **Include personal artifacts.**

For example, collectables and objet d’art from travels, inherited furniture and artwork, your

child’s drawings and pottery creations, gifts from friends, family photos, crochet throws and even caricatures and professional photos of your dog (OK, that’s just me).

I have a pair of wooden clogs sitting on my living room table. They were the shoes my great-great-grandmother wore when she came to the US from Sweden. My clogs are a conversation piece, but they also tie me to family and are a nice reminder of where I come from. Bonus, they look really cool!

## **Mix and match.**

If you like it, it will work. Some of the best spaces are an eclectic mix of styles, colors and time periods.
